Spring Term



Welcome back – it's 2026!

This term our overarching theme is 'Let's experiment!' Within this we have two main topics which will inspire our learning and environments – Amazing Materials in Spring 1 and Glorious Food in Spring 2.

MATHS

In F2 maths lessons the children will look in-depth at the numbers 5 to 10. They will be able to recognize odds and even numbers and know doubles. F1 children will spend more time exploring shape, space and measure this term. As always, there will be lots of extension opportunities within our continuous provision.



LITERACY

Alongside daily phonics lessons and story times, we will have a main class book to learn new vocabulary, mark-make, sequence and retell.

EXPRESSIVE ART & DESIGN

We have lots of creative projects planned including collage and textiles. There will be a specific focus on drawing skills during week 4 and 5 of Spring 1 and we would love your child to bring in their favourite teddy bear to do a still life sketch!



UNDERSTANDING OF THE WORLD

During our materials topic we will investigate the sight, smells and touch of natural materials and what happens in the process of freezing and melting. This will lead onto the natural habitat of bears and where in the world bears live. When we move onto our food topic, we will explore the places and climates that fruits grow, and plant seeds to help us begin to learn about the life cycle of plants.



COMMUNICATION AND LANGUAGE

All areas in the classroom promote and support speaking, listening and comprehension skills. During this term the children will:

Spring 1 - find out and talk about bears, learn 'The Bear Hunt' song and a Teddy Bear rhyme with actions;

Spring 2 – learn and talk about fruits and where they grow, do a Caterpillar rap and recite the poem 'Fuzzy Little Caterpillar'.
