### Our Play-Based Curriculum

Our nursery will be equipped with high-quality indoor and outdoor play equipment for children to explore and learn. We will ensure children feel safe, secure and happy whilst developing their communication, independence, sense of self and the world around them.

In the Autumn, children will explore what is special about them and things we celebrate like Bonfire Night, Christmas and Diwali through free play, stories and nursery rhymes. Children will receive certificates for 'Wow moments' and families will be invited to 'stay and play' and learn about our curriculum intent.

## Childcare Funding

From September 2025, eligible working parents of children under the age of 5 will be entitled to up to 30 hours of free childcare per week for 38 weeks of the year (term time).

For Autumn term starters, the deadline to apply for funding was 31<sup>st</sup> August 2025 as outlined in our previous newsletter.
